## **IEO MEMBERS SUCCESS AT VADA/NOVA COMPETITION**

Neither rain nor wind could deter the crew of Cool Breezers from the season's first outing. There were new horse/rider combinations to test out, new levels to be conquered and qualifying scores to be had.

First in the ring was Evelyn on her homebred AWS gelding, Rockingham, out of their late stallion, Manahawk. This was the first recognized outing for the beautiful chestnut and he was a superstar. Despite the rain & muck, he went around like a seasoned trooper, placing 4<sup>th</sup> in both his Saturday Training Level Classes. On Sunday, he placed third in both classes with two scores of 69%. And just like that, he is qualified for the BLM Championships and needs just 1 more score for the GAIG champs. He is such a big teddy bear of a horse; it is going to be fun to watch Evelyn take him up the levels.

Speaking of "up the levels", Evelyn's Grand Prix horse, Fellipe, had a new rider and a new job for the first show of the year. The 22 year old Dutch gelding helped USDF "R" judge, Heidi Berry, get a qualifying score for her "S" judge's license. The two had a great Intermediate II test, earning a 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish. Heidi has been practicing hard with Flip throughout the winter and is having fun learning all of his buttons and quirks. Flip, the consummate competitor, loves to get out there and show his stuff.

Young Rider Paige Johnson had an outstanding first outing with Black Hawk, the Fresian gelding she is leasing from Sandra Holcomb. What a winning combination! They won both their Training and First Level test 4's, with scores of 65 & 66%. Paige has been a student of Evelyn's for a little over a year and travels from Lancaster to work with her. Next up for Paige will be her First Level freestyle, where she & Hawk will surely shine.

Kristin Herzing and her Hanoverian gelding, Gentleman, won all 3 of their Fourth Level classes – earning qualifying scores for the BLM's, GAIG's & Dressage at Devon. They also made their Prix St George debut, and placed 4<sup>th</sup> in a competitive field with a 60%.

Katherine Nelson and Beloved MRF earned 62% at Musical Freestyle (sole rider in the class).

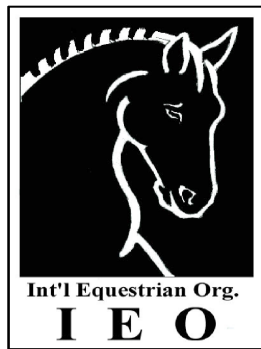
